



Defence Training Review

Nationwide survey of Ministry of Defence (MOD) property

The Defence Training Review was established to undertake a fundamental re-examination of MOD's individual education and training system. Its aim has been to build on Britain's strengths, particularly in training for operations, and to adapt current practice to meet the challenges of the 21st century.

BPG were commissioned by Carillion Construction to carry out a condition survey of 4 establishments involved in the MoD's defence training review. The sites were spread across the country and involved the survey of 300,000 m2 of buildings including mechanical and electrical services.

The buildings ranged in type and included large warehouse facilities, accommodation blocks, mess and restaurants, gyms and fitness centres together with specialist storage, workshop and testing facilities.

The fieldwork for the surveys was carried out by a team of 6 surveyors over a 6 week period. Analysis and reporting followed within 4 weeks of the field work completion and the results presented to Carillion and partners.

Develop survey data collection software including electronic quality assurance procedures and training.

Carry out the survey on a number of typical sites and properties.

Manage the data input and reporting output.
