### The brief:

To carry out a stock condition survey of 250 buildings, structures and related assets belonging to the Royal School of Military Engineering at Chatham and Minley.

The stock comprised a wide range of building types, from Grade II listed buildings to new build accommodation including many types of industrial, educational, religious, sports and leisure assets and special military training structures.
